Recruitment and Appointments: The City put out an ad.

September National Literacy Month: Barbara Vest discussed the ongoing partnership with the Lakewood Library to show off local celebrities and their top 3 books. She is open to other ideas. Bob Lawrence said that the Clover Park Rotary is looking to partner with their 3 year financial commitment to literacy.

Asian Film Festival: Phil Raschke passed out a sign in sheet for members to participate

in the Asian Film Festival. Volunteers should bring a small flashlight and wear clothes that fit the theme. Phil made a motion for the board to authorize the lodging tax grant. Bob Lawrence moved. Kathy Flores seconded. Motioned approved unanimously.

Arts Fest: Bob said in the future an ideal location for a large scale Art Festival would be the City Hall parking lot or Fort Steilacoom Park. It could include having cars from Lemay, the Bell Ringer group, and other entertainment. This year it is taking place in conjunction with the Asian Film Festival. Sally ordered awards.

Concert in the Park: Susan Coulter announced that The Tacoma Concert Band and American Legion band will be performing at Fort Steilacoom Park on August 20th. The American Legion starting at 2pm. The Tacoma Concert Band starting at 6pm. Sally Martinez is working on getting the Stacks Burgers food truck to be there. Bob Lawrence made a recommendation to the board to try to get Tops in Blues to do a concert when they visit Fort Lewis. Sally Martinez will buy additional chairs.

Rotating Art for City Hall: Bob Lawrence made a motion to approve the new artwork. Motion approved unanimously.

Gallery space at the Historical Museum: Ed Kane advised that the commission has a corner at the Historical Museum for an art display.

Art Space at the Lakewood Play House: The playhouse has offered space for a rotating exhibit. Likely every 6 weeks when the plays change.

Permanent Art Collection: The discussion continued about creating a permanent art collection for Lakewood City Hall. The commission is looking to set a criteria for the art that will potentially be purchased. This project will be a few years out due to expense and location.
