APPROVAL OF MINUTES

COORDINATOR'S REPORT

The **Lakewood Community Collaboration** meeting on February 14 produced some ideas to improve school partnerships and increase community coordination efforts.

- Create a funding matrix that identifies major funders and their funding priorities
- Develop a partnership list for distribution to all collaboration members
- Explore centralized location to for a community resource center
- Explore ways to build relationships with school personnel and parents
- Have a media campaign about the effects of trauma and fear
- Host another Poverty Immersion Workshop with the school district
- Include dedicated networking time at each collaboration meeting
- Promote self-care and mindfulness in the human service workforce
- Provide more data about the Lakewood community to the general public

The **Lakes High School Job Shadowing** event scheduled for March 28 was cancelled due to liability issues and not enough school staffing to mitigate the risk. Community partners have been notified. We will need to discuss how to address this strategic objective at a future meeting.

What's UP Lakewood newsletter spring edition will be ready the second week of April. Community partners have been asked to submit news and information by March 16.

The CPSD is exploring new ways to share community resources with the school population using Peach Jar. Mary Dodsworth suggested that a focus group of community partners be organized to discuss the impacts of changing the What's UP Lakewood newsletter into an emailed publication vs. the quarterly newsletter that is printed and distributed to all the schools in the CPSD.

Community-wide initiative in April could center on Healthy & Safe Kids. There are a lot of community activities in April; the YMCA Healthy Kids Day and the City of Lakewood Parks Appreciation day, which we could build upon. It was discussed that more time will be needed to coordinate this effort for next month, but a possible focus for the coming year.
