# **APPROVE MINUTES - FINANCIALS**

- The budget balance is now \$1,468.44

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- Recruitment, resignations, and Appointments: Linda noted that 3 positions are open. Encouraged everyone to spread the word! Chelsea Roberts resigned.
- Concert Series Planning: Airica reported we have secured the bands for 3 dates: 8.14 (Triple Treat) 8.21 (Electro Swing) 8.28 (Candy Shoppe). 6-7:30pm at Fort Steilacoom Park. Airica suggested getting the Dusty 45's for next year. Sally Martinez is writing a lodging tax grant for 10,000. The bands should be chosen and schedule by February 2019 to go in the Spring/Summer Issue of Connections Magazine. Once we have a better idea of how many people attend, we can bring in food trucks. This year Sally will try Kettle Corn and frozen yogurt vendor.
- MLK Essay Contest essays: 6 were distributed. 3 were turned in to Kat who is collecting them (Kat, Daryl, Julie) The others will be given to Kat by 8.15.18.
- Juried Art and Literary Committee. Esther Finney Art Reception Recap noted that very few people attended. This is a trend. It was discussed how to improve attendance by partnering with local businesses and restaurants. Linda encourage the members to reach out before our next meeting to see who may be

- interested (i.e. Barnes and Noble, Bleu Note, Hop Jacks). Sally mentioned putting out more signage and Aframes. Thursday night may be a better night than Monday. Suggested having student submissions for each reception. Suggested having it at a high school on a night where there is another event to draw people. Save the date: Carolyn Burt + Kristin Johnson reception Monday October 22, 2018 5-7pm @ Lakewood City Hall. However it may be changed if we can find a partner.
- Film Festival Committee Update. Phil said that next year Bob Lawrence's nonprofit organization may be taking over the Film Festival. Sally confirmed later in an email that this is the case. So the Arts Commission will not be involved in 2019. Kat is in charge of volunteers and they are actively recruiting. Information will go up on the City Website. There are now 41 authors. A series of articles are running in the Sub Times of interviews with the authors. Next meeting is August 16<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 at the Ram.

   Connections Magazine Content Due now for fliers. Vendor packets are ready. Lani will work on the parade. Lego contest is from 12-2. Clover Park gave us approval for use of the Stadium for staging.
