Rotating Art: Lani is working on acquiring art for City hall for the fall.

Original Artists Film Festival: Noah Thomas, intern for the City has completed his internship. He populated an Airtable account to keep track of everything from applicants to awards. Since he put so much time into it, he may be back to volunteer. A tentative date is in October 2020. Lani suggested LAFF (Lakewood Arts Film Festival) for the name. The board liked the name but did not finalize a vote. Applying for the lodging tax grant in 2021 after the first year, was discussed.

MLK Committee: Kat Flores is still waiting for a few of the reviewers to submit scores. She suggested that the sub-committee meet to have an in person discussion since the scores seem to be vastly different.

Holiday Committee: The holiday event will have a generous sponsorship of \$5,000 from CHI Franciscan. The committee shared the draft flyer. There will not be a 5k this year. There will just be a Jingle Bell Dash right before the parade.

Summer Concert Series: The concert series is going well. The band with the biggest audience was the Beatles Tribute band. Sally is writing a lodging tax grant for 2020 and asking for more money to bring in better bands with a bigger following.
