VOLUNTEER VETERAN MENTORSHIP



Are you a Veteran looking for a chance to help other Veterans?

Are you looking for a volunteer opportunity where you can share your knowledge of navigating Veteran issues with Veterans in need?

Are you willing to be assigned a justice involved Veterans and have weekly contact in person, over the phone or e-mail?

Are you willing to attend Veterans court or Veterans forums once per month in support of your fellow Veteran?

Are you able to pass a background check?

If you answered yes to all of these questions and would like more information feel free to contact the Veterans treatment court probation officer at 253-983-7825. Our Veterans court offers the following things to the Veterans you would be mentoring:

- Non adversarial court designed as a group approach at addressing issues related to each participant's case.
- 12-24 months Stipulated Order of Continuance. Upon successful completion of the program the charges are dismissed or amended to a lesser charge per agreement.
- Monthly court appearances with weekly meetings with probation. Court is held on Wednesdays at 2pm.
- Urine analysis testing weekly to ensure compliance with maintaining a sober life style.
- Regular weekly communication with volunteer peer support mentors who are also veterans.
- Bike program used to assist veterans with transportation issues.
- Veterans' Treatment Court Forums where participants and mentors come together for dinner and presentations on veterans issues.
