

District was formed to address invasive aquatic weeds like milfoil

- Eurasian watermilfoil (milfoil) identified in American Lake in 2016
- District formed in 2019 for a 10-year period
- Property owners pay \$0.66/ft.
- JBLM not part of district but pays a proportional share






2019 and 2020 District Budgets:

- 2019 Revenue: \$75,000 grant + \$44,313 assessments = \$119,313
- 2019 Expenditures: Estimate: \$131,000; Actual = \$124,619
 - Difference in revenue and expenditures was anticipated to be covered by a loan from the City's stormwater utility, to be paid back by the district over the life of the district
- 2020 Revenue: Estimate: \$33,099; \$25,742 collected YTD
- 2020 Expenditures: Estimate: \$29,320; \$9,988 spent YTD

Milfoil spread from 106 acres in 2017 to 166 acres prior to the treatment in 2019

Before and after 2019 treatment - southwest of the Fish & Wildlife boat launch





Tentative 2021 Work Plan

- Develop 2021 work plan, budget, and schedule at the November Advisory Committee meeting
- Work plan will be reviewed and adopted by the City Council in early 2021
- Tentative work plan includes:
 - Vegetation surveys (before, during, and after control activities as needed)
 - Invasive aquatic weed control/treatment
 - Public education and outreach (to be determined)
 - Review treatment activities at the end of season
