Community Solutions

The City has been intentional to build relationships with and among vulnerable communities. Gentrification may be one of several economic pressures driving up cost of living. Typically the term is used for the process of middle-class housing "take overs." But other factors are contributing, such as manufacturing /commercial redevelopment, intensification of low paying jobs, for example. We look to other communities around the country struggling with the same issues of abundant lowpaying jobs, expensive housing, insufficient infrastructure, and substance abuse, and we do not see anyone that has figured out real solutions. Lakewood is particularly skilled and able to collaborate and work together to solve problems, so we have as good a shot as any to lead the way on these issues.
