- Each entry is encouraged to 'go all out' in decorating their vehicle/float and wearing festive clothing, making it fun and exciting for participants and spectators alike. Prizes will be awarded (see contest details below).
- The Lakewood "reverse" parade is a stationary display of floats and vehicles. In this revers scenario, it is the viewers who will drive by while the floats and displays remain in one place.
- Businesses, clubs, and organizations can have signage on their vehicle, but lighting and decorations should reflect the Holiday Season.

PARADE DATE: Saturday, December 12, 2020

PARADE VIEWING: 6:00 - 8:00pm

CHECK-IN/ASSEMBLY: 4:00pm (Call Sally if you need more time)

Location: Perimeter Road, 5711 Main Street SW, Lakewood, Washington 98499

(Behind Barnes & Noble in Lakewood Towne Center)

<u>CHECK-IN STATION:</u> All entries must stop at the check-in station located at the entrance to the staging area. There you will be directed to set up on a first come, first serve bases. All parade participants will receive a map closer to the event date of where to check in. **Important: To reduce congestion, please appoint one member of your group to check in your entire group.**

<u>PARADE SET UP/BREAK DOWN DAY OF:</u> The staging area will be in the parking lot behind Barnes and Noble in Lakewood Towne Center. Your vehicle/display will stay stationary the entire time. **After the parade, please clean your staging area before you leave.**

JUDGING: Categories include: Most Original, Most Spirited, and Best theme. Winners will be prented a trophee that night.

RESTROOMS: Honey buckets will be located in the parking lot.

Lakewood Reverse Parade of Lights Rules

This is a Lakewood community parade. Our goal is to provide a community parade that is safe and enjoyable for both participants and spectators. To that end, we ask the following:

- You may have a representative hand out packaged candy to the cars. But please don't throw it.
- SANTA CLAUSE Only the official parade Santa is allowed, no other vehicles/floats can have a Santa on board
- o The Parade goes rain or cold.
- o Decorative lighting must be UL approved and rated for outdoor use.
- No candles allowed on floats. Fire or open flame on any entrant is prohibited.
- o Smoking is prohibited on any float or parade entry
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on any float or vehicle or on the person of any participant.
- All entrants must conform to the description stated in their application.
- Entries depicting violence, drugs, and illegal activities or otherwise deemed inappropriate will not be allowed for this family friendly parade.
- The City of Lakewood reserves the right to bar from the parade at any time any entrant refusing to follow the instructions of the police or parade officials.
- All entrants must clean up after their entry (animal waste, garbage in staging, decorations, etc.)
