Lakewood Drive-in Movie Rules

- We are operating at reduced capacity. Therefore, you must have a reserved spot for admittance. No tickets will be sold at the door!
- Every person must have a seat belt.
- The ticket price is \$15 is per vehicle, not per person.
- You must have a printed copy of your registration for entry. No exceptions.
- No RV's, buses or limousines.
- Headlights must be turned off. Other distracting lights on, in and around your vehicle, including strobes, neons, blinking/flashing novelties, video displays and TV sets must also be turned off.
- If you or your family are sick, or think you may have been exposed to someone that has contracted COVID-19 please stay home!
- Customers Guests who do not follow these rules will be asked to leave. No funds will be given asked to leave.
- The movie will show rain or shine.
- No "out & in". If you leave during the evening, your ticket may not be used to re-admit you to the drive-in.
- Never put a light of any sort onto the screen, including spot lights and laser devices.
- Please leave your pets at home, as we cannot allow "potty walks" for them.

Parking Instructions

- Gates open at 7:00 pm for parking until 8:15 pm. Movie will begin at 8:30 pm.
- You MUST park where attendants direct you to park
- Guests may not park within 10 feet of another vehicle.
- No saving spaces. All parking is first come, first served per section.
- Hatches must be kept at a level no higher than the roofline of your van or SUV. You can have the
 tailgate of your vehicle up or windows rolled down provided that you do not impede the view of
 other vehicles and comply with all other guidelines. If you plan to open your hatch, we
 recommend you bring rope or a bungle cord to hold it down to be level with your roof.
- Cars will be parked by height. During registration, you will be required to provide your vehicle height so we can accommodate parking as best as possible.
- Upon entry, we will look at your printed registration form and direct you to your spot.
- Section 1: Small vehicles under 5'
- Section 2: Mid-sized vehicles between 5' 6'
- Section 3. Large vehicles over 6'
- Section 4. Vehicles with open hatches that exceed 6'
- ***We recommend enjoying the movie facing forward. However, if you would prefer to back into your parking spot and open your hatch, we will place you in section 4 at the back. In the rare case that your vehicle can remain between 5' and 6' with the hatch open, we will place you in Section 2.

Be Cool Safety Rules

- *MASK UP for entry at the events.
- *You must remain in your vehicle at all times except to visit the restroom or concessions. We recommend only one person go to the restroom or concessions at a time.
- *Please wear a face mask if you need to leave your car.
- *Please practice 6-ft social distancing.
- *No walk-ups. This is a vehicle ticketed event only.
- Movie Audio Movie audio will be broadcast on an FM signal so you can listen on your car or portable radio. We do not have an app for audio.

Prohibited Items:

- No glass containers. No alcohol allowed in a City Park or this event
- No smoking or vaping of any kind including tobacco or cannabis allowed in City Parks or this
 event.

Allowed:

- Outside food and beverages are allowed.
- Food: We will have food trucks for your foodie pleasure.

Be a good Guest!

- Please be aware of your impact on others as you enjoy this event. Any groups making noise that is disruptive to hearing the movie will be asked to leave.
- Please pack out your own trash. We have reduced staff this summer so your cooperation is appreciated.
- If you must leave before the movie is over, please use fog lights, be aware of any pedestrians who may be walking to or from the restrooms and use the established exit.
- If you have a medical emergency, please call 911 and let our security staff (in a yellow vest) be aware so they can guide the response to your vehicle.
- The City is not allowed to use jumper cables, so please have a plan should your car battery die.
