# Western State Hospital Master Plan Comment Matrix

The City of Lakewood received a proposed update to the Western State Hospital (WSH) Master Plan in fall 2020 that includes the complete reconstruction of the hospital and its campus near Fort Steilacoom Park. Lakewood is the lead agency for environmental review of the proposal under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA). A Revised Master Plan application and Revised SEPA Checklist were submitted to Lakewood in May 2021. The City reopened public comment on both documents between June 7 and July 7, 2021. The period was extended to July 12, 2021 to account for unanticipated downtime of the City's web portal. The City issued a Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance on June 6, 2022 with a comment period ending on June 27, 2022. On June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022 the City issued the Public Hearing Notice with a comment period ending on July 26, 2022. The comments submitted up to July 17, 2022 are identified in the matrix below in summary fashion by the name, topics, and date of the letters/comments.
