All contractors must be licensed, bonded and insured in the State of Washington. All firms must become a lead-based paint certified renovator through the Washington State Department of Commerce, Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) program to conduct work on any home constructed prior to 1978.

Lead- paint abatement firms must also be certified through the Washington State Department of Commerce for all abatements, inspections and riskassessments for lead-based paint.

When using the Small Works Housing Repair/Rehab Roster to award contractors, the City will invite proposals from those on the Roster. The contract will be awarded to the contractor submitting the most responsive bid depending on the area of specialty. Additional applications are available at:

Process

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. General Contractors and Lead-Based Paint Abatement Contractors desiring to participate may complete a Contractor Qualification Questionnaire (included with this packet and also available from the Community Development Department CDBG Division, 6000 Main Street SW, Lakewood, WA 98499-5027).
- 2. The Questionnaire must be completed and returned with copies of the following documentation attached:
 - a. State (General) Contractor's License (L&I)
 - b. City of Lakewood Business License
 - c. License of Incorporation (if applicable)
 - d. Certification for lead-based paint repair and remodeling activities or evidence of class enrollment (RRP certification or Lead Abatement Contractor certification, as applicable)
 - e. Insurance policy for liability (business, minimum \$1,000,000 with the *City of Lakewood* and the *Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority* named as coinsured)
 - f. State Sáles Tax Certificate (Dept. of Revenue Business License)

Please also include:

- a. One completed Verification of Information form (included in this packet) from your bank for credit reference verification.
- b. Please sign the additional copy of the form for verification of business credit references. We will complete the top portion and send to your business credit references.

- Upon return of the completed questionnaire, with supporting documentation, City staff will verify all information furnished; visit job site where the Contractor has worked; determine the quality of work, whether work was performed in accordance with the specification; and whether the property owner was satisfied with the job.
- 4. If, in the opinion of the City staff, the Contractor meets the stated qualifications, the questionnaire and the supporting documentation will be approved by the City of Lakewood and then submitted to the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board of Directors.

DEBARMENT:

The following irregularities may constitute consideration for debarment of a Contractor:

- 1. Failure to start work within ten (10) days of receipt of the "Notice to Proceed", unless otherwise agreed.
- 2. Failure to provide on-site supervision of work force.
- 3. Failure to coordinate arrival and departure of work force with property owner.
- 4. Failure to perform work in accordance with approved specifications.
- 5. Changing the scope of work without properly executed Change Order.
- 6. Continued failure to pay Subcontractors as agreed, upon receipt of a progress draw.
- 7. Failure to honor the Contractor's Guaranty and Warranty as specifically relates to:
 - a. The guaranty of all work performed
 - b. Keeping the premises clean and orderly during the course of work, and
 - c. Assignment of the contract without written consent of the City of Lakewood and the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority.
- 8. Failure to complete the project within the prescribed period without an approved extension of the completion date.
- 9. Failure to maintain proper and required contractor certifications and licenses.
- 10. Failure to honor the Performance Bond to the homeowner(s), the City of Lakewood and/or the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority.

The City of Lakewood and/or the TCRA may debar any General Contractor who, within a two- (2) year period, is found to have allowed any of the stated irregularities to exist without an explanation acceptable to the City of Lakewood and/or the TCRA. Qualification and/or debarment procedures shall be in addition to the factors used by the City of Lakewood and/or the TCRA to determine the lowest and best responsible bidder.

City staff will monitor all jobs; record any irregularities; attempt to resolve any problems in a mutually acceptable to the property owner and Contractor within the limits of the terms condition of the contract.

The TCRA Board of Directors adopted this procedure on March 19, 1992. The City of Lakewood formed a HOME Consortium with the City of Tacoma (Tacoma Community Redevelopment Board) for funding housing rehabilitation programs using U. S. Department Housing Urban Development HOME Investment Partnership Act funds effective July 1, 2000.

E-VERIFY REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTORS

By Ordinance, the City of Lakewood requires that all contractors who enter into agreements to provide services or products to the City use the Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system when hiring new employees for the term of the contract.

E-Verify is an electronic system designed to verify the documentation of job applicants. It is run by the Department of Homeland Security.

Who is affected?

- All contractors doing business for the City of Lakewood. There is no minimum dollar value for contracts affected.
- All subcontractors employed by the general contractor on these contracts.

Are there exceptions?

- Contracts for "Commercial-Off-The-Shelf" items are exempted from this requirement.
- Individuals, Companies, or other organizations who do not have employees.

How long must the contractor comply with the E-Verify system?

• For at least the term of the contract.

Are there other stipulations?

- E-Verify must be used <u>ONLY</u> for <u>NEW HIRES</u> during the term of the contract. It is <u>NOT</u> to be used for <u>EXISTING EMPLOYEES</u>.
- E-Verify must be used to verify the documentation of <u>ANY</u> new employee during the term of the contract, not just those directly or indirectly working on deliverables related to the City of Lakewood contract.

How will the City of Lakewood check for compliance?

- All contractors will retain a copy of the E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding that they execute with the Department of Homeland Security <u>AND</u>
- Sign and submit to the City an Affidavit of Compliance with their signed contract.
- All General Contractors will be required to have their subcontractors sign an Affidavit of Compliance and retain that Affidavit for 4 years after end of the contract.
- The City of Lakewood has the right to audit the Contractor's compliance with the E-Verify Ordinance.
