Project Description

The City of Lakewood has received Safe Routes to School (SRS) grant funding for the design of the 112th St SW – Lake Louise Elementary School Sidewalk Project.

This is a sidewalk project along 112th St SW between Holden Rd SW to Farwest Dr SW consisting of curb, gutter, sidewalk, and bike lanes, limited stormwater facilities, street lighting, excavation and resurfacing of the roadway.

The City of Lakewood will complete the civil design with in-house staff and will contract separately for other professional services including environmental as necessary.

This project will include all necessary aspects of topographical survey services including horizontal and vertical control, surface generation and base map preparation. The surveyor shall also be able to map out right-of-way lines, parcel lines, and parcel information.

The City requests that statements of qualifications include the ability to provide all of the above services. The City reserves the right to negotiate a reduced scope of services with the successful consultant and obtain other consultants for specific project elements.

Qualifications

Qualified consultant teams shall show experience with the following:

- 1. Demonstrated experience in conducting topographical surveys for capital improvement projects including roadways, sidewalks and public infrastructure.
- 2. Proficiency in using surveying equipment and software tools (e.g., total stations, GPS, laser scanners) and software (e.g., AutoCAD, Civil 3D).
- 3. Strong track record of completing projects on time and within budget constraints.
- 4. Proof of professional qualifications and licenses.
- 5. Experience with projects of similar size and scope.

Evaluation Criteria

The statements of qualification will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- 1. Project team experience and qualifications including key personnel.
- 2. Understanding of the project requirements.
- 3. Project team's experience with topographical survey and right-of-way mapping.
- 4. Familiarity with WSDOT and FHWA Standards and requirements.
- 5. Approach to project.
- 6. Past Performance and references.

The RFQs will be evaluated by a committee comprised of City staff. The top two (or more) consultants will be invited to interview with the evaluation committee. Interview format will be determined and shared after the RFQ's are reviewed. Final selection for this project will be based on a combination of interview results, RFQ's, and past performance and references.

Qualification Requirements

The City encourages disadvantaged, minority, and women-owned consulting firms to respond.
