WHEREAS, the nearly 2 million Americans served in the Korean War; and

WHEREAS, the alliance between the United States and South Korea formed in 1953 following the end of the Korean War and since then the United States has maintained a strong military presence in South Korea where approximately 28,500 troops are stationed; and

WHEREAS, the alliance has grown beyond military cooperation, with economic and cultural ties strengthened over time; and

WHEREAS, the organizations like the Korean American Association of Tacoma play a crucial role in supporting the community; and

WHEREAS, the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Korean War is an opportunity to recognize the hardships and sacrifices and heroic contributions made during the Korean War.
