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City of Lakewood Camp Discipline Policy

The City of Lakewood has implemented the following rules to ensure the safety of all campers, staff, and the facility. A progressive discipline program is in place and is noted below. Our purpose is to create a safe and fun environment for all.

Camper Expectations - All campers will:

- 1) Respect camp counselors, fellow participants, equipment and property.
- 2) Follow the directions of the Camp Counselors and be cooperative.
- 3) Not use vulgar language/actions.
- 4) Not engage in hostile or dangerous conduct.

Camp Staff Will:

- 1) Use preventative management techniques by providing structured play time as well as free play.
- 2) Encourage self-discipline by encouraging campers to be involved in the discipline process.
- 3) Correct negative behavior in a timely manner and recognize positive behavior.
- 4) Establishing and consistently enforcing camp rules and guidelines.
- 5) Act as positive role models.

Progressive Discipline Plan:

- 1) **First Offense:** A Behavior Report will be filled out by staff as well as the camper(s) involved. This report will be presented to the parent(s) at the end of the day (or as soon as reasonably possible) before the camper is checked out, and the parent will be asked to sign the report. This alerts the parents to the offense and there will be a behavior contract put into place.
- 2) **Second Offense:** The Camp Manager speaks with the parents and a suspension is likely.
- 3) **Third Offense:** Dismissal from the program is considered.

Examples of Serious Offenses Which May Result In Immediate Dismissal from the Program:

- Causing physical harm or threat to others
- Physical or verbal assault
- Sexual misconduct
- Refusal to Cooperate
- Temper Tantrums
- Weapons, Drugs, Tobacco
- Destruction of Property
- Stealing
- Leaving the Designated Area
- Excessive late pickup

*If a suspension or expulsion is necessary, all fees will be forfeited for the current session. Prepaid fees for future sessions may be refunded less a \$10 administrative fee per week.

I understand that inappropriate behavior will be recorded and tracked throughout the time that my child is involved in Camp. I have read and understand these policies and have explained them/read them to my child prior to the start of camp and will support the progressive discipline process.

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Late Camper Policy

Camp ends at 5:00 pm. It is very important you pick your child up on or before 4:59 p.m. A late warning will be given for the first time you are late.

After the late warning you will be charged \$10.00 for every 5 MINUTES past 5:00pm throughout the camp season.

- 5 minutes \$10.00
- 10 minutes \$20.00
- 15 minutes \$30.00
- 20 minutes \$40.00
- 25 minutes \$50.00
- 30 minutes \$60.00

The balance must be paid to the City of Lakewood before the end of the camp week. If not paid camper may not be able to attend next session.

I (we) further agree, individually and on behalf of the above-named child, to release and hold harmless the City of Lakewood, its officials, employees, volunteers and agents and agree to waive any right of recovery that I (we) may have to bring a claim or lawsuit for damages against City of Lakewood for any personal injury, death or other harmful consequences occurring to the above-named child or me (us) arising out of the child's voluntary participation in this activity and/or being transported to and from the activity. 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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Pick up/Drop off:

For safety reasons all children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at drop off and pick up; **photo I.D. will be required**. Each child must be signed in/out by a parent/guardian that is listed on the emergency contact form. Please add any additional persons that may pick up your child prior to the start of camp. Staff is not authorized to release a child to any persons who are not listed on the emergency contact form! Staff will need to be given advanced notice, if you need to pick up a child prior to the end of the day.

Attendance and Late Policy:

Camp starts at 8:00am and ends at 5:00pm Monday-Thursday, including field trip days. Please drop your child off on time. If your child will be late or absent on a field trip day, please notify the Parks and Recreation Department by calling 253-983-7887. Please note that camp fees are non-transferable and non-refundable.

If you pick up your child after 5:00pm, you will be charged a late fee of \$10 for every five minutes thereafter. You will receive a warning on the first occurrence but after the next occurrence you will be charged accordingly: 5 minutes = \$10, 10 minutes = \$20, 30 minutes = \$60, and so on. The late charge will be added to your account, to be paid before the last day of the current session. Failure to pick up your camper by 5:00pm may result in dismissal from the program.

Transportation:

Field trip transportation will be provided by chartered school buses and drivers. Campers will walk with staff to activities within walking distance.

What to Wear:

All children should wear comfortable clothing, suitable for play and should always wear closed-toe shoes. Flip flops and sandals are NOT permitted except in the swimming areas. Any special apparel or shoes needed for field trip days will be noted on your weekly camp calendar. When kids have fun their clothes may get dirty.

All belongings including clothing, backpacks, towels and lunch boxes should be labeled with your child's first and last name and should be placed in a bag or backpack that is easily portable. Items left at camp will be placed in a lost and found until the last day of camp. Unclaimed items will be donated to a clothing bank after the summer season. The City of Lakewood Parks and Recreation department is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

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Sunscreen:

Please put adequate sunscreen on your child BEFORE dropping them off at camp as well as pack additional sunscreen for the day. Staff will remind campers to self-apply sunscreen throughout the day. Spray Sunscreen is recommended.

Meals:

- Please pack a lunch, snack, and a refillable water bottle for your child

Health Policies:

Campers who have contagious conditions (i.e. Pink Eye, Chicken Pox, lice) or who feel ill in any way are not permitted to attend camp. As a precaution, please notify a staff member if your child has been exposed to a contagious condition.

If your child becomes ill while at camp, a parent will be notified. If no parent can be contacted, the emergency contact(s) will be called. If no party can be reached and the symptoms worsen, 911 may be called.

Injuries:

All Lakewood Parks and Recreation staff is CPR and First Aid Certified. Staff will administer basic First Aid for minor injuries such as scrapes and cuts. If an injury occurs, parents will be notified ASAP. If a child needs medical treatment, the parent will be notified. Staff will follow the following procedures in the case of a serious injury: **Call 911 → Administer First Aid/CPR → Contact parent or emergency contact → Incident Report. Parents will be informed if their child has been treated during the day**

Discipline:

It is the policy of camp staff to use progressive discipline to ensure the safety of all the campers, facility and other staffers. If a serious offense occurs, a staff member will complete an incident report to be signed by the staffer, child and parent/ guardian prior to the child being signed out for the day. If the behavior continues a second time, the camp staff will notify the parents and a suspension may be required. If a third offense occurs, dismissal from the program will be considered.

*If a suspension or expulsion is necessary, all fees will be forfeited for the current session. Prepaid fees for future sessions may be refunded.

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
